



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q | What ages do you accept?

A | We accept children age 4 to 17. Families must have a child at least 4 years old to apply. Nursery and Toddler rooms are available for younger siblings, if needed, while parents fulfill service hour requirements.

Q | How are classes/ages grouped?

A | Our classes are grouped by age: Primary: 4-5-year-olds; Elementary: 6-8-year-olds; Lower: 9-11-year-olds; Upper: 12+ year olds

Q | What type of classes do you offer?

A | We offer elective and enrichment-focused classes that supplement and support the core subjects taught at home as our children grow and develop a deeper understanding of God's purpose for their lives.

Q | What are the obligations of your members?

A | M4M Homeschool Co-op can not function without our member involvement. Members are required to fulfill 15 service hours per semester along with clean-up duties. Teaching a class is encouraged but not required. Service hours can be fulfilled by assisting with 2 classes per meeting day.

Q | Can I drop my kids off and pick them up at the end of the day?

A | No. We require at least one parent/guardian to be on campus during meeting hours.

Q | How much does it cost?

A | \$140 per family per year or \$80 per family per semester. Any additional class fees will be communicated in advance.

Q | What days and times do you meet?

A | We meet bi-weekly on Friday from 9:30-2:00 **EASTERN** time. We aim to have 10 meeting days per semester.

Q | Are you accredited?

A | We are not accredited nor do any of our classes seek to replace home course work. Our classes are designed to supplement core subjects taught at home while providing the added benefit of group participation.

Q | I missed the enrollment deadline, can I still apply?

A | Yes, you may still apply and your family will be added to our waitlist for the upcoming semester.

Q | Where do you meet?

A | We meet at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Bryant, AL.

Q | Why do you require a background check?

A | At M4M, following host facility standards, we believe the safety of our children and member families is of upmost importance and feel the background check adds an additional layer of protection for our members.

Q | I missed the scheduled Open House, can I still meet everyone?

Q | Will my child have fun?

A | We absolutely believe our member families have fun on any given co-op meeting day.

Q | Do I have to teach a class?

A | No, parents aren't required to teach a class. However, we highly encourage parents to give it a try!

A | No, families are expected to provide their own lunch and drinks. We have several microwaves for families to use, if needed. We've even been known to bring along our Instant Pot and Crockpots!
