

Destination built, the ships will make their debut on the Rhône and the Seine, giving you the opportunity to be among the first aboard if a France river cruise is in your future.

Destination built, the newest riverboats to join our fleet are designed to ensure picture-perfect cruising along the Seine and Rhône rivers.

- Cruise the Seine aboard a new 410-ft. long riverboat with a maximum capacity of 124 guests in just 62 cabins
- Cruise the Rhône aboard a 443-ft. long riverboat with a maximum capacity of 130 guests in just 68 cabins
- Over 80% of cabins will measure 225 sq. ft. or larger, including 20+ 300 sq. ft. Tauck Suites to carry on our tradition of more space per guest
- Each ship will include 12 new 180 sq. ft. Category 1 cabins featuring 20% more space and larger bathrooms, with no single supplement charges
- Reimagined common areas and outdoor spaces invite with picturesque scenery and pleasant temperatures on the Rhône and Seine


Greek Odyssey: Family Edition
