Purpose of the Concept

-  Create formal Sector Representation aligned to SETAs
-  Strengthen coordination between national, provincial, regional, and sectoral stakeholders

Provincial Responsibilities

-  Provincial coordination of NSDPA activities
-  Stakeholder engagement on provincial level
-  Oversight of regional structures
-  Reporting to the NSDPA Governing Board




Regional Representatives

Each region will have a Regional Representative (Lead) and a Supporting committee (where applicable)

Responsibilities:

-  Represent providers within their specific district/region
-  Identify local challenges and opportunities
-  Facilitate communication between providers and the provincial structure
-  Support local initiatives, workshops, and engagements

Regional Value

-  Ensures bottom-up participation
-  Improves real-time issue identification
-  Enhances member engagement and accessibility
