Rev. Ayanna Solomon, Founder and President of Jesus in the City, a Christian movement that proclaims the Gospel of Jesus Christ through music, arts, and culture, is a visionary ministry leader, nonprofit executive, and creative arts advocate with over 25 years of experience mobilizing churches and communities in Canada and internationally.

Since founding the organization in 1999, she has led the growth of the annual Jesus in the City Parade in Toronto—one of Canada's largest Christian festivals—uniting hundreds of churches and drawing tens of thousands. The movement has also expanded into the Caribbean, with initiatives in Grenada, Jamaica, and St. Kitts & Nevis.

A passionate communicator and worship leader, Rev. Solomon has ministered across the Caribbean, North America, and Africa, equipping leaders through worship and leadership training, and has taught on Creative & Innovative Evangelism at the Billy Graham Canada Evangelism Leadership Conference.

She has also served as a worship pastor, Bible instructor, and missionary, including establishing a Bible training institute in the West Indies.

She is the founder of Solomon Media Productions, supporting ministry and community engagement through media and design. Ordained in 1998 under Ministers Network Canada, her leadership has been recognized with multiple community awards, including honours from the Toronto Police Service.

Rev. Solomon is committed to equipping individuals to discover their purpose, fostering unity in the Body of Christ, and advancing the message of Jesus through culture, creativity, and community.



SUSAN BEST

Worship Leading 101

Susan Best is an anointed worshipper, psalmist, author, songwriter, and producer with a voice dedicated to the glory of God. Originally from Grenada and raised in the Virgin Islands, she began singing at the age of 7 and has never stopped since. Over the years, she has released eight albums, including the EP *Oceans* and three singles: *My Rock*, *This Is My Now*, and her latest, *Yahweh*.

Her ministry has taken her across the Caribbean, the United States, London, and South Africa. Most recently, she participated in Praise Fest 2025 in St. Kitts & Nevis and hosted PIVOT, a night of prayer, praise, and worship. She continues to serve as a worship leader at gospel events worldwide and was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel in 2014.

In this workshop, Susan will briefly revisit the foundational principles of worship, but her primary focus will be on the practical aspects of leading in a corporate setting—our personal conduct as worship leaders, how we prepare, and how we effectively execute worship. With the understanding that worship is not just an act but a lifestyle, she challenges participants to approach it with intentionality, integrity, and consistency, both on and off the platform.
