

# **Gethsemane Cemetery Regulations**

It is important to be considerate of the families around you and the cemetery staff. Placing multiple decorations or inappropriately sized decorations not only encroaches on the space of other families near your monument, they can also prohibit the cemetery grounds crew from adequately mowing the grass and can pose a risk to injury.

During mowing season (April thru November), articles on graves must be within the outer limits of each marker's foundation. No permanent plantings or wreaths allowed next to your loved one's tombstone.

## **MAXIMUM OF 2 (TWO) ARTICLES PER GRAVE**

(2 articles could represent 2 floral arrangements **OR** 1 floral arrangement and 1 small statue, **OR** 2 small statues)

The following are **NOT** allowed.

- Candles
- Metal Objects (stands, easels, shepherd hooks)
- Breakable items (glass, ceramic, lawn ornaments)
- Grave coverings of any type
- Landscape material such as bushes, border edging, or decorative stones
- Solar Lights

Please remember that Gethsemane is open to the public and we are not responsible if placements are moved, stolen, or damaged due to natural occurrence.

We ask for your cooperation by visiting your loved ones in a reverent and respectful way. Please abide by these rules and regulations so that all families may feel welcome when visiting Gethsemane Cemetery.

Gethsemane Cemetery reserves the right to remove any decorations at any time that do not conform to our policies, pose a safety risk, have become weathered/damaged, or interfere with our day-to-day operations or maintenance.
