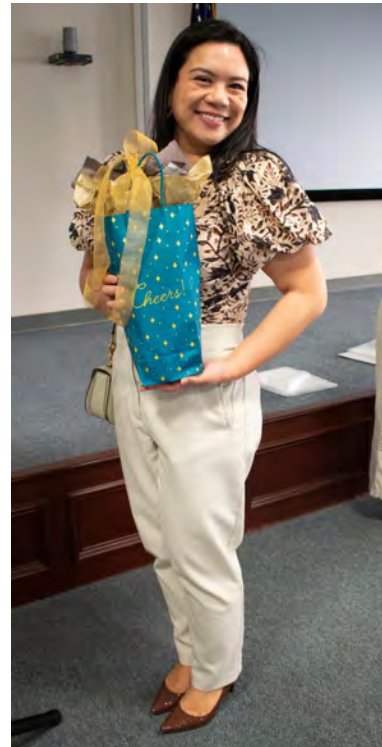

## **Member Spotlight: Trendy Thai – A Family Story of Flavor, Resilience, and Community**

Nestled along the busy corridor of Arrow Highway and Irwindale Avenue, Trendy Thai is a hidden gem serving up authentic Thai cuisine with deep family roots and a story of perseverance.

At the heart of the kitchen is the owner's mother, whose journey as a chef began in Laos, where she was born and raised by her Vietnamese parents. Her love for cooking started early and continued as the family relocated to Sacramento and later Southern California. It was there that she refined her skills in Thai cuisine, learning techniques rooted in authenticity—including influence from a former royal court chef.

Today, her cooking is the foundation of Trendy Thai's menu, delivering dishes that are both traditional and deeply personal.

The family's journey to Irwindale wasn't without challenges. Prior to opening Trendy Thai, they operated another Thai restaurant in the Arcadia/Monrovia area that ultimately did not succeed. Determined to continue pursuing their dream, they relocated to Irwindale in 2017—and have remained a staple in the community ever since.

Like many small businesses, Trendy Thai faced significant hardship during the COVID-19 pandemic. Once supported by steady business from nearby corporations such as Spectrum and Southern California Edison, the restaurant experienced a sharp decline in patronage during and after the lockdown period. While recovery has been gradual, there has been a renewed sense of momentum. Since joining the Irwindale Chamber of Commerce in December, the restaurant has seen an increase in referrals and community support. In February, they took another step forward by expanding their hours to include Saturdays.

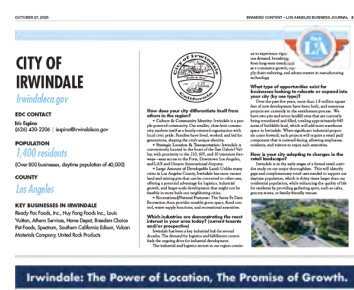

### Ontario Offers Homeowner Financial Assistance:

The city is offering the **"Keys to Community"** program to assist potential and current homeowners. [Submit an interest form here](#)

- **First Time Homebuyer Program:** Provides up to a \$120,000 deferred loan for down payment and closing costs.
- **Housing Rehabilitation Loan:** Offers a \$30,000 no-interest loan for eligible homeowners to make essential home repairs like roofing, plumbing, and electrical work.
