



## 2020 Four Chords

35% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Cabernet Franc,  
22% Malbec, 18% Petit Verdot  
Adelaida

14.50% ABV    pH 3.67    TA 6.0 g/L

### *Vineyard*

2020 was a warm year with high heat spikes in August and September. The Winemakers monitored the hot spells and increased watering to maintain quality fruit. 100% of the fruit for this blend comes from our Adelaida Vineyard. With a mix of clay and calcareous soils in the Adelaida Vineyard, the wine exhibits pronounced acidity, full tannins, and strong structure.

### *Winemaking*

Fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks, followed by 22 months of aging in 90% new French oak barrels. This Bordeaux blend focuses on showcasing the strengths of each variety. Cabernet Sauvignon provides the backbone of the structure, Petit Verdot contributes floral notes, Malbec adds volume, while Cabernet Franc introduces red fruit and minerality. There were 576 cases produced of this vintage.

### *Tasting Notes*

2019 Four Chords presents a vibrant nose of blueberry pie, freshly smashed boysenberry, ripe dark and blue fruit, and red flower aromas. On the palate, its tightly wound structure elevates flavors of boysenberry, coffee, cocoa nibs, and a hint of flint. Full-bodied with slightly tight but very fine tannins, it is compact and layered, delivering a very long and deep finish. Enjoy now through 2036.
