Wow, what a good night we had at Night to Shine! If you do not help with this special event, I strongly encourage you to get involved next year. The look on the guest's face is priceless. Words can not describe the night; you need to be here!

Recent data show that while many Americans still identify with a church community, **the average churchgoer in the U.S. attends about 1.6 times per month** — roughly two out of every five weekends. (Barna Group)

What's especially interesting is how attendance varies by generation. Among younger adults, **Generation Z (roughly ages 18-28)** now attends most frequently, averaging about **1.9 services per month**. Close behind, **Millennials (ages ~29-44)** average **1.8 times per month**, marking the highest levels of regular weekend worship recorded among younger generations in recent years. (Tenton Monitor)

By contrast, **Generation X (ages ~45-60)** sits near the national average at about **1.6 times per month**. Older cohorts — **Boomers (ages ~61-79)** and **Elders (80+)** — both average closer to **1.4 monthly attendances**, reflecting longer-term declines in regular churchgoing. (Trenton Monitor)

These shifts show not only evolving patterns of participation, but also a surprising resurgence of commitment among younger adults — even though overall attendance remains far below weekly levels. (Barna Group)

Do these numbers surprise you? Is it any wonder we have had around three hundred folks join in the past six years, and our average worship attendance has not changed much? One last question: What do you consider "regular weekend worship"? In other words, how many times in five weeks, since this is the metric of this study, would you consider regular attendance? I would love to hear from you about this.
