WHAT IS GIVE WHERE YOU LIVE?

Give Where You Live is a 24-hour community fundraising effort on **December 4, 2025**, led by the **Kearney Area Community Foundation** (KACF) that will unite donors to support **207 local nonprofits and causes**, while improving our quality of life. (See inside for a list of participating nonprofits.) KACF brings the Give Where You Live campaign to area nonprofits in order to achieve three main goals:

- Raise awareness of the current philanthropic needs of our community
- Help local nonprofits identify and cultivate new funding streams
- Inspire donors to increase their support of their favorite local causes

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Kearney Area Community Foundation contracts with Neon One to provide an online giving platform. There is a processing fee of 3% for all donations.* (This is one of the lowest platform fees in the country.) Local nonprofit organizations are invited to participate in the community-wide campaign and are asked to verify that 100% of funds raised during Give Where You Live will stay local.

WHY SHOULD I DONATE?

\$135,000 in matching funds and prizes will be given to nonprofits participating in Give Where You Live! Each organization is eligible for a proportional share of the \$100,000 Challenge Match Pool provided by the Kearney Area Community Foundation and sponsors.
