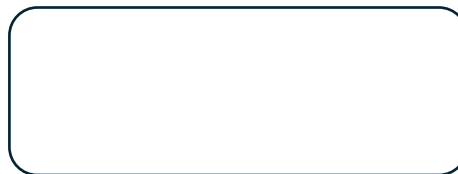

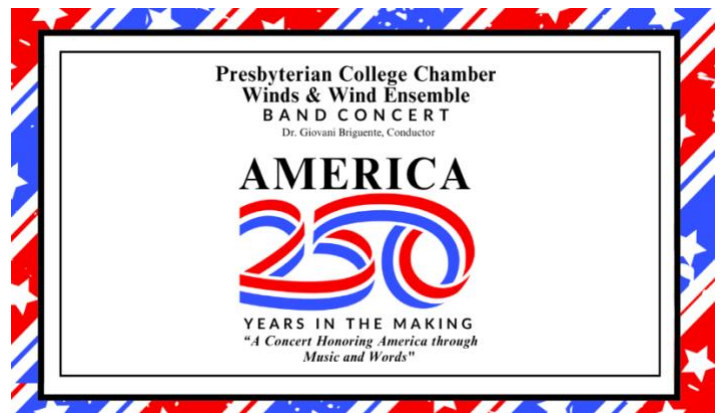


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!
