Adult Sunday School Classes

Our Adult Sunday School classes meet at 9:30 a.m. in various classrooms around the church. Below is a list of classes offered for adults with descriptions and age ranges:

Chapel Class

The Chapel Class meets in the Chapel each week and studies the bible by using books such as the *Interpretation Bible Series*. A study on Corinthians will conclude February 11, and after a 5-week Lenten study led by Dr. Dixon, the next study will be on Exodus beginning April 7. The Chapel class is largely a class of retired folks, but all ages are welcome and appreciated.

College Class

The College Sunday School Class is geared toward all collegeaged students and led by Karen and Van Mattison. It meets during the school year when Presbyterian College is not on break. Various topics are discussed. Breakfast is served during the class. The class meets in the Junior High Fellowship room in the CLC.

Crossroads Class

The Crossroads Class consists primarily of couples in their 40s and meets in Room 111 of the CLC. Most members have children ranging in age from around 8 to 26 years old. Our lessons this year are from a variety of videos, and the class is led by various members.

New Horizons Class

The New Horizons Class meets in Room 216, upstairs in the Sunday School Hall. A diverse group from many different Christian backgrounds, deep topics of discussion with a side of fun describes this group of 50-70 somethings. All are encouraged to participate and ask questions as we learn and discover the bible together.
