Meeting Minutes:

- Called to order at 7:03 pm
- Public participation
 - Conflicts with lacrosse/soccer scheduling and field use – Parks & Rec have been slow to finalize schedules
- Treasurer update: Herb
 - Nick: family on fields during practice; to be addressed with Newtown Parks & Rec
 - Franklin Templeton not liquidated yet – message in to broker to help w/transaction
 - Discussed payment to NCC for use of conference rooms
 - Equipment spending for goals, etc.
 - General update on latest spending and receipts for winter training, coaches, etc.
 - To discuss future investments for excess cash
- Travel update: Jeff
 - Uniforms still in process of being developed – working on design
 - Working on ordering branded tents, hopefully in time for tournament
 - Spoke w/Joe about potential to have rec plus teams involved in new uniforms as well – TBD based on timing of when to order vs. start date
 - Scheduling w/P&R: ongoing discussions with field time between lacrosse and soccer. Getting more time/turf back. Also bringing more bathrooms
- Rec update: N/A

- Development update: Kyla
 - Enrollment is a little lower than expected – projected much higher. At 145 right now, at 180 in the fall. Numbers looked like should have been around 215 for spring. Spring usually grows by 40 kids.
 - Wording on how early bird special was delivered needs to be addressed on website
- Equipment update: Carol Ann
 - Onboarded new coaches for travel – ordered pinnies & cones
 - Updated med kits for travel & rec
 - Ordered jerseys for academy & rec (should be good for fall jerseys for academy as well)
 - Extra sandbags (9) – to be brought to middle school and confirm what is needed
 - Yellow anchors – slowly putting on fields; more sustainable than sandbags
- Memorial Day tournament update: Laura
 - 63 teams officially registered already – more verbally confirmed (ahead of PY registrations at this time)
 - Merch – signed w/different apparel vendor. Minimum 20% kickback, willing to do multiple locations. Will be available for pre-order.
 - Food – instead of food trucks, Kyla is working w/local restaurants to do bundles to be delivered to the fields. Restaurants willing to donate a portion of proceeds back to club.
 - Eric hard at work on sponsorship solicitations.
