ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF VOLUNTEER OBLIGATIONS

As required by statute, I fully understand that:

1. If I am arrested for or convicted of a Disqualifying Offense as defined by Pennsylvania Code 23 PA. C.S.A. Sec. 6344 (c) or named as a perpetrator in a founded or indicated report I must provide written notification of the same to the President of the Laurel Recreation Association (herein referred to as the "LRA") no later than 72 hours after the arrest, conviction or notification that I have been listed as a perpetrator in the statewide database.
2. If the LRA has a reasonable belief that I was arrested or convicted of a Disqualifying Offense as defined by Pennsylvania Code 23 PA. C.S.A. Sec. 6344 (c) or was named as a perpetrator in a founded or indicated report, the LRA can require me to update my clearances before being permitted to continue to volunteer for the organization.
3. Willful failure to disclose this information is a misdemeanor in the third degree.
4. My clearances will expire on _____ (5 years from the date of the oldest clearance submitted).
5. In order to efficiently protect the volunteer's confidential information the LRA, will only list my name, within their database of persons who have submitted clearances to be used for volunteer selection purposes only. Reports and information contained on the reports will remain confidential to the extent permitted by law.
