"Increase our faith" is a strange sort of request (Luke 17:5).

Jesus had already told his disciples the parable of the mustard seed, so they already knew that size is deceptive. Now he tells them that even a tiny amount of faith is sufficient to command a mulberry tree -- with its extensive root system to uproot itself and plant itself in the sea. In other words: You want your faith to increase? Use it! Like a servant who becomes better at serving by regularly serving, whether in the field or in the home, a disciple grows in the Lord's service by steadily serving the Lord. In his second letter, Paul asks Timothy to "bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God"

(2 Timothy 1:8). In other words, practice your faith, even when it's difficult, and God will give you the strength you need. God gave Habakkuk the strength he needed when he despaired of the destruction and violence he saw around him. God showed him a vision of the world to come, assuring him that "the just one, because of (his or her) faith, shall live" (Habakkuk the strength he needed when he despaired of the destruction and violence he saw around him. the world to come, assuring him that "the just one, because of (his or her) faith, shall live" (Habakkuk 2:4). If you want to increase your faith, act with justice amidst the strife, live out the gospel in the face of hardship, and serve the Lord always. This will suffice.

We will be praying the First Friday Rosary in the church at 6:30 PM on Friday October 7th. All are welcome.






Tickets for CCW's November 6th Bunco Fundraiser will go on sale October 8th after all masses and at Donut Sunday.

Last week, Bishop Barron reminded us that God does not need our sacrifice, but we need to sacrifice.

This week, Fr. Burke Masters will reveal the background and the importance of the Preface, the Sanctus, and the Epiclesis.

Saint of the week

This saint has the honor of having founded a religious order which, as the saying goes, has never had to be reformed because it was never deformed. No doubt both the founder and the members would reject such high praise, but it is an indication of the saint's intense love of a penitential life in solitude.

Bruno was born in Cologne, Germany, became a famous teacher at Rheims, and was appointed chancellor of the archdiocese at the age of 45. He supported Pope Gregory VII in his fight against the decadence of the clergy, and took part in the removal of his own scandalous archbishop, Manasses. Bruno suffered the plundering of his house for his pains.

He had a dream of living in solitude and prayer, and persuaded a few friends to join him in a hermitage. After a while he felt the place unsuitable and through a friend, was given some land which was to become famous for his foundation "in the Chartreuse"—from which comes the word Carthusians. The climate, desert, mountainous terrain, and inaccessibility guaranteed silence, poverty, and small numbers.

Bruno and his friends built an oratory with small individual cells at a distance from each other. They met for Matins and Vespers each day and spent the rest of the time in solitude, eating together only on great feasts. Their chief work was copying manuscripts.

Hearing of Bruno's holiness, the pope called for his assistance in Rome. When the pope had to flee Rome, Bruno pulled up stakes again, and after refusing a bishopric, spent his last years in the wilderness of Calabria.

Bruno was never formally canonized, because the Carthusians were averse to all occasions of publicity. However, Pope Clement X extended his feast to the whole Church in 1674.
