

PRAYING WITH THE SALVE REGINA

As you know, we have been singing and praying the seasonal Marian Antiphon at the end of most Sunday Masses here at St. Mary's since Lent began. We started with the Ave Regina Caelorum, and the response was beautiful from our parish. So, we decided to pray the Regina Caeli during Easter season. Now, the next seasonal Marian Antiphon is the Salve Regina, or the Hail, Holy Queen. This text is perhaps the most familiar to us as American Catholics as it is the closing prayer of the Rosary!

We will be incorporating the singing of the Salve Regina into most of our Sunday Masses during this next stretch of ordinary time. While it will usually be sung immediately after Mass as our closing hymn, you may hear it other places in the Mass as well. Whenever we sing it, we invite you to sing, meditate, pray, and join your own prayers to those of our congregation as we ask Mary to intercede for us. As the patron saint of our parish, St. Mary is a most powerful intercessor for us.

In the back of the Church you will notice a new wooden box where you can anonymously submit your own prayer intentions. Please use this box to write any prayer intentions you have, and each week as the Marian Antiphon is sung, the choir and I will lift each written intention up in prayer. We invite you to join in these prayers for each other as you sing and pray with us.




