A note from Fr. John

St. Mary's Parishioners,

As I write this, not counting my recent vacation, I am ending my third full week at St. Mary. I want to give a few thoughts and updates since my arrival. As I have expressed at weekday and weekend Masses, I could not be more grateful to be assigned by Bishop Hicks as your pastor. In my brief experience, the people of this community are humble, welcoming and take extreme ownership in parish matters. The amount of work and service put in by parishioners is beyond what I expected. I am very thankful for this high level of ownership from so many parishioners. I am also thankful to Fr. Tuan for his wise and holy stewardship over the past 11 years. As former pastor, along with hundreds of you, he led our parish in an excellent direction. This has allowed for an ideal transition for me as your newly appointed pastor. I am thankful to Fr. Tuan and to all of you.

Although this is my 7th year as a priest, it is my first year as a pastor. I promise I have been and will continue to work hard to expand the Kingdom of God in our parish community and the larger Minooka area. That being said, I ask for your patience. I know I will make many mistakes in my inexperience. I have many limitations that I am aware of and many I'm not aware of. I also know that after 11 years of a humble holy priest serving you, it's probably not easy having a new shepherd. I will try my best to be humble and learn from my mistakes. I will do my best to earn your respect and trust. Thank you ahead of time for your patience with me.

As you may know, Deacon. Fred has moved on from his position as Religious Education Director. In consultation with members of Bishop Hicks' leadership team, I have created a new position called *Director of Evangelization*. This full-time position will encapsulate three main responsibilities. This person will be the Director of RE, Director of Youth Ministry and assist me and the St. Mary's Church in implementing Bishop Hicks' vision of evangelization in our parish and the greater Minooka area.

I will give more details on this vision of evangelization as we move forward. In short, we want to bring as many people to Jesus Christ and the fullness of His Catholic Church as possible. This includes Catholics who no longer practice their faith, other Christians, non-Christians and those who are indifferent to Jesus Christ or do not believe in God. This is our obligation as Christians and of the greatest importance. It is in line with the teachings of the Church throughout history, following Jesus' *Great Commission*, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you" (Matt 28:19-20).

If you know any possible candidates for this new position, please invite them to apply. In the meantime, Heather Flanigan and Jeff Wunderlich have graciously stepped in to help fill some of the responsibilities of this crucial role. I am deeply indebted to Heather Flanigan for being our Interim Director of Religious Education. She can be contacted with questions at re@stmarysminooka.com. Please also contact Heather if you can help as a Catechist!

Finally, we are still in need of additional volunteers for Catechists for Religious Education, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Lectors, Altar Servers and Mass Coordinators. Mass Coordinator is a new position that will help coordinate all of the ministries for each weekend Mass. Please discern if you are called to one of these ministries. Please do not be intimidated by them. There will be extensive training. If God is asking you to serve in one of these ways, He will bless the work of your hands. 


