

### A note from Fr. John

I am trying to be intentional about our bulletin covers to help shed greater light on the scriptures. From time to time, I would like to explicitly clarify connections between the scriptures and the chosen image. -Fr. John

Here are a few notes concerning our current bulletin image:

- John the Baptist is depicted as the main subject.
- As in most art John as the subject, John is pointing away from himself toward Christ (here represented with the cross in John's left hand).
- In John's left hand, his fingers are grouped by three and two. The three represent the Holy Trinity, of which Christ is a member and the two represent Jesus as both God and man.
- The three fingers are above and the two below united by the cross which communicates Christ's cross as the bridge uniting man to God. The cross of Jesus is the bridge to enter heaven and the life of the Holy Trinity. "Unless you pick up your cross and follow me, you have no life within you. (Mt 16:24-26)"
- John wears camel skin as his garment. He is thin because he is living a sparse life of penance, fasting, and prayer in the desert.
- His gaze is towards heaven, rather than this earth.
- The background color is sandy brown and gold representing the desert as a place/state where purification and salvation are found.

Rehearsals will be on Sundays following the 9am Mass in the church basement.






## Children's Christmas Play
