

Dear Parishioners,

Here is a reflection for this weekend's Masses:

Luke tells us that before multiplying the loaves and fishes, "Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God" (9:11). That's no surprise. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus spoke about the kingdom of God constantly. It is the inheritance of the poor (6:20). It is filled with good news (8.1). It is like a mustard seed: tiny, but producing a huge bush (13:19). It is like a sprinkle of yeast that leavens a whole batch of dough (13:21). It is where those who were last will be first (13:30). It is to be accepted like a child (18:17). It is more difficult for a rich person to enter than a camel to pass through a needle's eye(18:25). It is promised to the good thief on the

Cross (23:43). Today it is here among thousands of people, hungry and tired at the end of a long day, lacking any food but five loaves and two fish, but where after Jesus blessed these ridiculously meager provisions and the disciples passed them out, they are and ate and this was exactly what Jesus had just spoken about. "For behold, the kingdom of God is among you" (17:21).

How have you experienced the kingdom of God among you?

Question of the Week

What does the Bible say about the pope / papacy?

ANSWER

The Roman Catholic Church's teaching about the pope ("pope" means "father") is built upon and involves the following Roman Catholic teachings:

- 1) Christ made Peter the leader of the apostles and of the church (Matthew 16:18-19). In giving Peter the "keys of the kingdom," Christ not only made him leader, but also made him infallible when he acted or spoke as Christ's representative on earth (speaking from the seat of authority, or "ex cathedra"). This ability to act on behalf of the church in an infallible way when speaking "ex cathedra" was passed on to Peter's successors, thus giving the church an infallible guide on earth. The purpose of the papacy is to lead the church unerringly.
- 2) Peter later became the first bishop of Rome. As bishop of Rome, he exercised authority over all other bishops and church leaders. The teaching that the bishop of Rome is above all other bishops in authority is referred to as the "primacy" of the Roman bishop.
- 3) Peter passed on his apostolic authority to the next bishop of Rome, along with the other apostles who passed on their apostolic authority to the bishops that they ordained. These new bishops, in turn, passed on that apostolic authority to those bishops that they later ordained, and so on. This "passing on of apostolic authority" is referred to as "apostolic succession."
- 4) Based upon the claim of an unbroken chain of Roman bishops, Roman Catholics teach that the Roman Catholic Church is the true church, and that all churches that do not accept the primacy of the pope have broken away from them, the original and one true church.

RCIA

If you or someone you know is interested in becoming Catholic or need to finish your Sacraments we have a program at St. Mary's for that. It is called RCIA or Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults.

The program will go through what it takes to become Catholic and what it means to be Catholic. Classes will begin in September and go through the Easter Vigil where you will receive your Sacraments. If you have any questions or would like to register, please call me 815 467-2769

Saint of the Week

Our Saint for this week is; St Junipero Serra.

Miguel Jose Serra was born on the island of Majorca on November 24, 1713, and took the name of Junipero when in 1730, he entered the Franciscan Order. Ordained in 1737, he taught philosophy and theology at the University of Padua until 1749.

At the age of thirty-seven, he landed in <u>Mexico</u> City on January 1, 1750, and spent the rest of his <u>life</u> working for the <u>conversion</u> of the peoples of the New World.



In 1768, Father Serra took over the missions of the Jesuits (who had been wrongly expelled by the government) in the Mexican province of Lower <u>California</u> and Upper <u>California</u>(modern day California). An indefatigable worker, Serra was in large part responsible for the <u>foundation</u> and spread of the Church on the West Coast of the United States when it was still mission territory.

He founded twenty-one missions and converted thousands of Indians. The converts were taught sound methods of agriculture, cattle raising, and arts and crafts.

Junipero was a dedicated religious and missionary. He was imbued with a penitential <u>spirit</u> and practiced austerity in sleep, eating, and other activities. On August 28, 1784, worn out by his apostolic labors, Father Serra was called to his eternal rest. He was <u>beatified</u> by Pope <u>John Paul II</u> on September 25, 1988. His statue, representing the state of California, is in National Statuary Hall. His <u>feast day</u> is July 1.
