From Fr. Tuan

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year that concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church. Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension into heaven.

Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room.

A strong wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages.

Here is a reflection for this weekend's readings:

Today we hear not only of the Holy Spirit coming down upon the apostles, but also of the witnesses in the streets of Jerusalem. People from all over the known world could hear the disciples speaking in their own tongue. The author of Acts goes on to say that after listening to Peter thousands of people chose to be baptized. The Holy Spirit came down and transformed the lives of the apostles, but immediately went on to transform the lives of thousands of others. We are those witnesses now. Like them, we received the Holy Spirit at baptism. Like them, we are diverse, with varied backgrounds, speaking different languages. The Holy Spirit also helps us understand each other and recognize the way we each express the glory of God. The Holy Spirit help us understand the cries of the family at the border fleeing fear and desperation, the hopes of the young person desperate for an opportunity, the pleas of the older person who was just laid off, the grief of those who lost family and friends in the pandemic. With the Holy Spirit, we gain the ability to truly understand each other, to bridge our differences-differences that flow from the mighty acts of God -- while recalling the first word the risen Lord pronounced to his disciples: Peace.

How can you express the peace that Jesus left us to those with whom you have differences?



Our Saint for this week is St. Ephrem Deacon and Doctor of the Church.

Saint Ephrem the Syrian was born sometime around the year 306 or 307 in Nisibis, a Syriac-speaking town located in the southeastern part of modern-day Turkey. At that time, the Christian Church was suffering under the persecution of the Roman Emperor Diocletian. It was long believed that Ephrem's father was a pagan priest, but evidence from Ephrem's own writings suggests that both of his parents may have been Christians, so his father may have converted later in life.



Question of the Week

O:

What is a Novena?

A:

The word novena derives from the Latin word for "nine." A novena is a series of prayers prayed over a nine-day or nine-hour period. The prayers are repeated to obtain special graces or as a sign of devotion to God. Usually a novena involves making a specific request or expressing a specific intent. Prayers may come from the rosary or from prayer books, or they may be written by the petitioner. Usually the same prayer is prayed every day for nine days, or the same series of prayers is prayed. A nine-day novena has prayers made at the same time each day; a nine-hour novena has a prayer at the same time each hour. Novenas are primarily practiced by Catholics, although some members of the Orthodox, Anglican, and Lutheran churches also say novenas.


