

A Message from Fr. Tuan

Dear Parishioners,

Here is a reflection for this weekend's readings (Twenty -sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year C)

We can all fall prey to selective blindness: a purposeful disregard of something we'd rather not see. The more comfortable our own lives are, the easier it becomes to ignore unpleasant things. Witness the rich man in the Gospel. His nice home, fine wardrobe, and sumptuous meals, he preferred to ignore poor Lazarus, his brother in the covenant of Abraham. Now he can see clearly, but it's too late. Amos, in the first reading, is even more critical of the well-off among the Israelites, complacent in their luxury while the kingdom of Northern Israel teeters on the edge of collapse. From Amos's time to Jesus' story, Abraham says that the rich man's brothers will not change even "if someone should rise from the dead" (Luke 16:31). But now someone has. Will we change?

Who is someone you have overlooked whom you realize now you should respond to with Christ's love and compassion?

Start Perfecting Those Recipes!

Our saints for this week are: Sts Cosmas and Damien:

Similar to Saint George, legends about Saints Cosmas and Damian far outrun any verifiable historical details about their lives. The devotion to today's saints across epochs and cultures is as broad as an ocean but as shallow as a lake. Upon a slender bed of long-lost documents is constructed the narrative that Cosmas and Damian were twins and natives of Saudi Arabia who studied medicine in Syria. They became known as the "moneyless ones" for refusing to accept payment for their healing services. They were likely martyred north of Antioch in the early fourthcentury. The earliest historical anchor planting these holy brothers in the ground of history dates to around 400 A.D. Around that time a pagan visitor recorded a visit to a shrine dedicated to Cosmas and Damian in Asia Minor. In the fifth-century, a church was built to their memory in Constantinople and, in the sixth-century, a pagan temple in the Ro-Forum was rededicated as a Basilica in their honor. The bright apse mosaic of Rome's Basilica of Saints Cosmas and Damian still shines and shows Saints Peter and Paul presenting the twins to the glorified Christ.
