An Important Announcement

Financial challenges are having negative impacts on nonprofit organizations nationwide and the Grafton County Senior Citizens Council (GCSCC) is no exception. As we plan for our upcoming fiscal year, which begins on October 1, we are identifying ways in which we can reduce expenses. We are being creative in our planning and we're prioritizing the continued provision of services for Grafton County residents who are older adults and/or adults with disabilities

In order to have a balanced budget in FY26 and ensure financial sustainability, some operational changes are inevitable. One change we are implementing is to combine Orford Area Senior Services with the Horse Meadow Senior Center in North Haverhill. We will no longer rent a physical space in Orford, yet we will continue to provide services as we do for all Grafton County residents.

This change saves a significant amount of money that we will apply towards the provision of services. The Orford location served residents of Orford and Lyme, and we will continue to provide services for those individuals. Homedelivered meals will continue with no changes, transportation will continue with our lift-equipped buses, and all are welcome and encouraged to attend congregate meals and activities at the Horse Meadow Senior Center or any of GCSCC's senior centers in Grafton County.

GCSCC's last day at the Orford Congregational Church location will be October 31, 2025. We thank the church leadership for their years of support and for their understanding of this change, as we continue to provide essential services for older adults and adults with disabilities living in Grafton County.


