

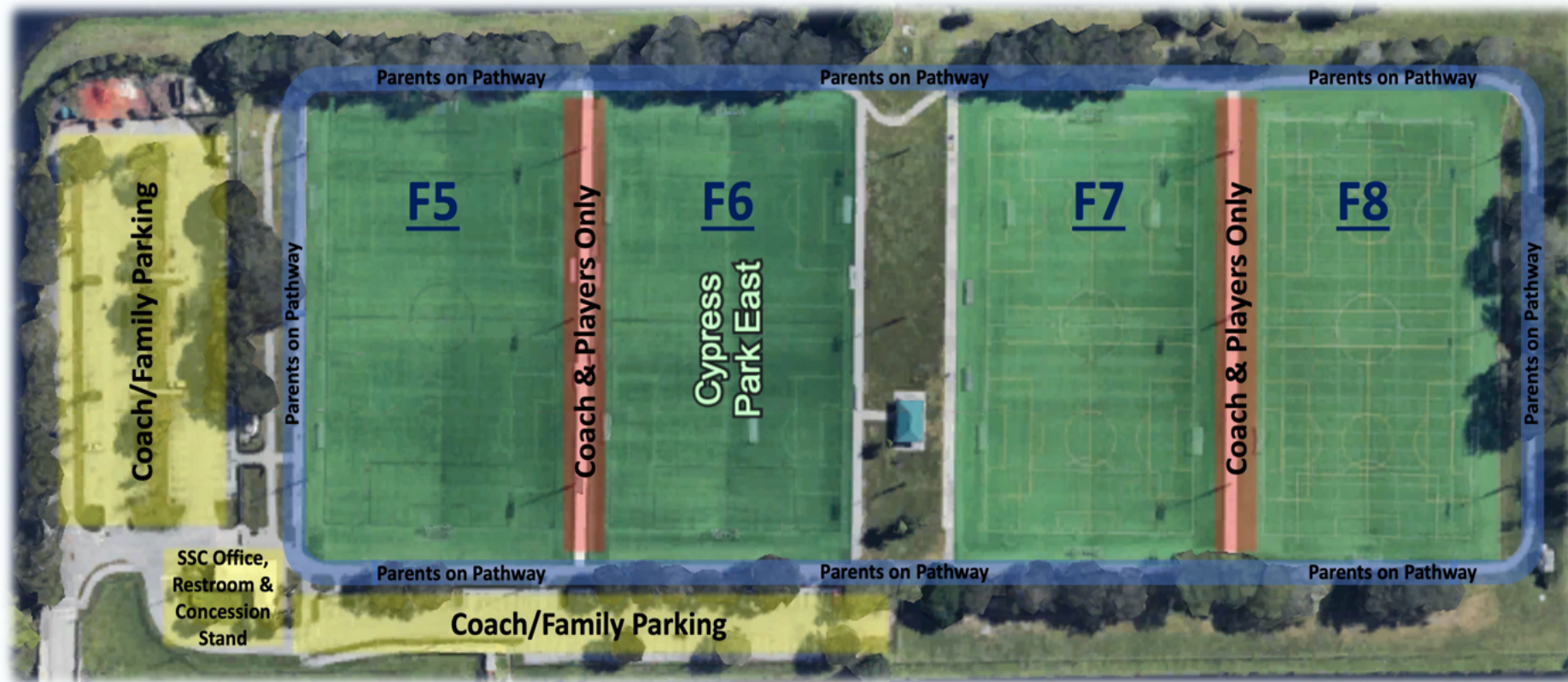

SPRINGS SC: FACILITY GUIDELINES (TRAINING)

The purpose of the facility guidelines is to ensure the club provides its teams, players, and staff with a professional and development-focused environment. As this is a Coral Springs facility, the club is also required to comply with all city guidelines related to facility management and safety protocols. The guidelines outlined below are intended to help ensure that all individuals involved are contributing to a safe, respectful, and appropriate environment during use of the facility.

- In case of lightning or bad weather staff, players and parents must leave the fields and remain in their vehicles until the all clear is given as per city ordinance (30 min. delay then all clear). This is controlled by the lightning meter onsite.
- Teams must clean up the trash after the training session has completed.
- Only Springs SC Staff & Players are allowed on the turf fields, as well as designated areas in between fields (areas highlighted in red on the map). In case of an emergency coaches will notify parents or the team manager.
- Walking/jogging is permitted only in the perimeter of the park. Parents are allowed on the concrete, please do not enter the turf fields (areas highlighted in blue on the map).
- Players waiting for parent pick up may wait by the shelter or office.
- E-bikes and bicycles must remain on the facility's paved sidewalks. Please be mindful of pedestrians and ride safely through the park.
- The concession stand/restroom is located by the main entrance and club office.
- When walking to a specific field, please use the paths around the fields and not through them during other sessions.
- The following is prohibited at Cypress Park per city guidelines:
 - a) illegal parking
 - b) no smoking
 - c) no pets
 - d) no alcohol or drugs of any kind
 - e) no noise makers or loud music
 - f) no weapons or fighting
- AEDs are located between field 6/7 & the concession stand in case of emergencies.
