



- Almost 30 Years Later






Reflection Questions


- How well do I take care of my body?

God of Gentle Whisper and of Fire

- ► Ministry Burnout: Gentle on Self
- ► Moral Failure: Ruthless on Sin
- ▶ Sinful Nature & Adversary the Devil



- ► WHY LED TO FALL?
- ► Sense of Entitlement: "After all the good I have done, I deserve something in return."
- Feeling of Invincibility: "I can do wrong."
- Lack of Accountability: "I report only to God."

- ► Hedge of Protection: "People around me will protect and cover for me."
- ▶ Rule of Exception: "This applies to others, not to me."
- ▶ Pain Relief: "This is my way to relieve stress and pain."
- ➤ **Sinful Human Nature**: "For what I want to do, I do not do, but what I hate, I do."

 Rom 7.15

- ► WHY LED TO HIDE?
- Our organization and ministry comes first: "If exposed, it will devastate our ministry. We will lose everything."
- Our leader and family: "We can't allow our leader and his family to be hurt."

- ► Sincere or Desperate Prayer: "God will help us to find a way out of this without too much of a fallout."
- ▶ Incredulity or Gullibility: "The accusers are of the devil. We can't believe the whistle-blowers."
- ▶ Sinful Human Nature: Like Adam and Eve after they sin, we hide from God. Genesis 3.8

SELF-CARE

- Recognise you can and will fall.

 1 Cor 10.12
- ► Have safe place to keep safe. Gal 6.1-2

SELF-CARE

- Write a Code of Conduct.
- ► Walk **in** the light—keep short accounts.
- ► Walk **into** the light—confess before exposure.
- Find safe place to recover.
