EAST PENNSBORO SCHOOL FIELDS PROJECT PACKET (EXECUTIVE SUMMARY)

Project Overview

The East Pennsboro Field Project is a multi-phase improvement initiative designed to enhance the quality, safety, and accessibility of the grass turf fields located at the East Pennsboro Middle School complex. The project focuses on turf health, increased playable space for soccer programming, and improved access for players, families, and students while maintaining ADA compliance.

This plan is structured into **three clearly defined phases**, allowing for controlled costs, minimal disruption to field use, and sustainable long-term field performance.

Field Map & Project Areas

The attached site map identifies numbered areas across the East Pennsboro fields:

- **Item 1, 2 & Item 3**: Existing grass turf soccer fields
- **Item 4**: Baseball field area to be demolished and converted into a new soccer field
- **Item 5**: Drainage crossing area for future pedestrian walking bridge

Items 1, 2, and 3 will receive the renovation services outlined in the attached turf maintenance proposals.

Item 4 will be redeveloped during Phase 2.

Item 5 will be addressed during Phase 3.



PASSION & PURPOSE

Phase 1 – Grass Turf Renovations (Items 1, 2 & 3)

Total Cost: \$19,100

Target Completion: November 2025 (Completed)

Scope of Work

Phase 1 focuses on improving the overall health, playability, and surface quality of the existing grass turf fields.

Included Services (per attached proposals):

- Core aeration of all grass fields
- Overseeding of wear areas using turf-type tall fescue
- Dragging aeration plugs to integrate seed into the soil profile
- Topdressing of two fields with USGA-spec sand to improve surface smoothness and turf density

These services collectively improve:

- Root development and turf resiliency
- Drainage and surface consistency
- Safety and durability for seasonal play

Vendor: Hummer Turfgrass Systems, Inc.

Phase 2 – Baseball Field Removal & New Soccer Field Construction (Item 4)

Estimated Cost: *\$25,000

Target Completion: June 2026

Scope of Work

Phase 2 converts the existing baseball field area into a **new multi-use grass soccer field**.

Key Elements:

- Demolition and removal of the existing baseball backstop
- Grading and leveling of the area
- Final field construction and grass preparation
- Creation of a new playable surface suitable for:
 - **7v7 soccer**
 - **9v9 soccer**

Project Benefits

- Adds a **new usable soccer field** without acquiring additional land
- Expands scheduling capacity for training, games, and school use
- Provides flexibility for younger age groups and small-sided play

Phase 3 – ADA-Compliant Walking Bridge & Access Improvements (Item 5)

Estimated Cost: Up to *\$15,000

Target Completion: September 2026

Scope of Work

Phase 3 addresses accessibility challenges by installing a **walking bridge over the existing water drainage area**.

Key Features:

- Safe pedestrian access for players, parents, and students
- Improved flow between parking areas and the new field
- ADA-compliant design to ensure inclusive access

Project Benefits

- Eliminates unsafe or inconvenient access routes
- Improves overall site usability and safety
- Maintain facility ADA compliance standards
