ISSUE

Shall the Village Board approve an ordinance amending Title 4 Chapter 5 Section 2 Unnecessary Noise Standards of the Village Code.

DISCUSSION

The Board discussed the proposed text amendment at the previous Village Board meeting on December 16, 2025 to amend the permitted construction hours in the Village. Over all the Board did not express any concerns over the proposed hours.

Staff researched surrounding communities construction hours and they all ranged somewhat, but for the most part were in line with the Villages current hours. Some communities did have different hours for weekends. After discussing this further with the Village President, it was determined that changing the hours from 6:30 am to 8:30 pm daily to 6:30 am to 8:30 pm Monday through Friday and 7:00 am to 6:00 pm Saturday and Sunday may be beneficial to Village residents.

COST

The cost associated to this would be to codify this text amendment.

**AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE TITLE 4, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 2: UNNECESSARY
NOISE STANDARD (CONSTRUCTION HOURS)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Sugar Grove (the “Village) is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution and, pursuant to the powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*; and,

WHEREAS, the Village deems it necessary and proper to amend its regulations by amending the current provisions and permitted hours of construction under 4-5-2, Unnecessary Noise Standard; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SUGAR GROVE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Title 4 – Chapter 5 – Section 2: Unnecessary Noise Standard

1. The following provisions of the Village of Sugar Grove Code of Ordinances shall be amended as shown in **exhibit A**, attached hereto.

SECTION THREE: General Provisions

REPEALER: All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its approval, passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

4-5-2: UNNECESSARY NOISE STANDARD:

J. Construction Or Repairing Of Buildings: The erection (including excavation), demolition, alteration or repair of any building other than between the hours of six thirty o'clock (6:30) A.M. and eight thirty o'clock (8:30) P.M. **Monday through Friday and seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M. Saturday and Sunday**, except in case of urgent necessity in the interest of public health and safety, and then only with a permit from the Building Inspector, which permit may be granted for a period not to exceed three (3) days or less while the emergency continues. If the Building Inspector should determine that the public health and safety will not be impaired by the erection, demolition, alteration or repair of any building or the excavation of streets and highways within the hours of eight thirty o'clock (8:30) P.M. and six thirty o'clock (6:30) A.M., and if he shall further determine that no loss or inconvenience would result to any party in interest, he may grant permission for such work to be done within the hours of eight thirty o'clock (8:30) P.M. and six thirty o'clock (6:30) A.M., upon application being made at the time the permit for the work is awarded or during the progress of work.
