Are You Finishing or Adding a Bedroom to Your Basement?

Don't forget your building permit!



Before starting your project, remember that a building permit is required when you finish or add a room to your basement.



Permits are essential for ensuring project compliance with safety standards, including egress, electrical, plumbing, and structural requirements. This is particularly important for basement bedrooms, where features like escape windows can be lifesaving.



Beginning work without the necessary permit can result in expensive corrections, delays, or fines. It's always wise to ensure everything is done correctly from the start!

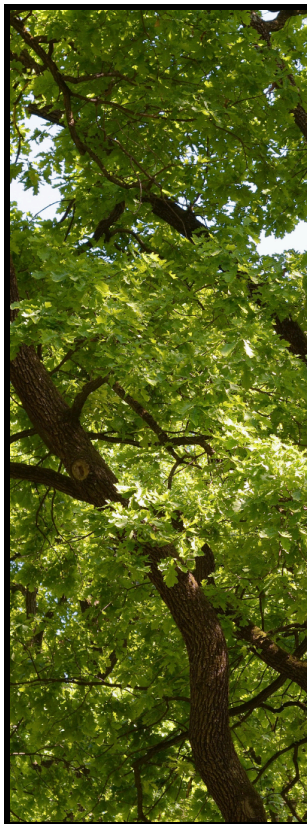

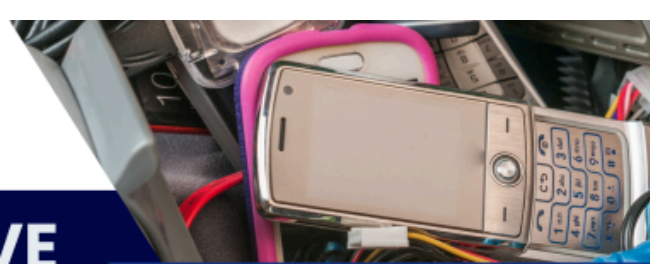
