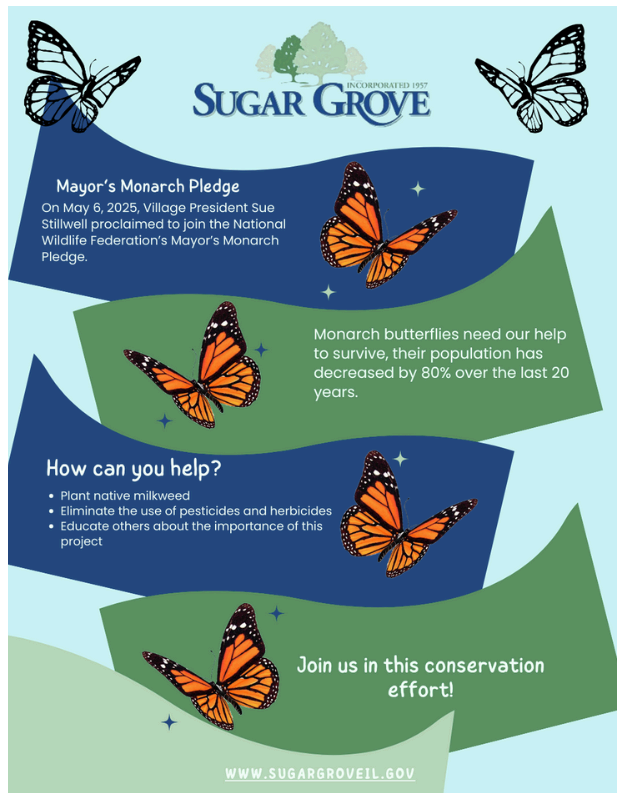

President Sue Stillwell has joined the **Mayor's Monarch Pledge**, an initiative by the National Wildlife Federation to protect the endangered Monarch butterfly. In Sugar Grove, we are making this a community-wide Monarch Project to support the cause. This presents a perfect opportunity for residents to contribute positively at home and in the community by creating habitats for Monarchs and other pollinators.

Actions, such as planting a pollinator garden or adding a few pollinator plants in pots, can make a significant difference. Some beautiful plants to consider for your pollinator garden include New England Aster, Coneflowers, Butterfly Weed, Goldenrod, and many others.

Garden markers will be available for participating gardens. To participate and receive a garden marker, please send a photo of your garden to ssillwell@sugargroveil.gov.

We are also excited to announce that on May 20, 2025, the Village Board voted to reinstate the Beautification & Gardening Committee, which will support the Monarch Project and other community initiatives.

To help you get started or enhance your already established pollinator garden, **Midwest Groundcovers** (6N800 IL-25, St. Charles) has generously donated 76 *Asclepias Tuberosa* (Orange Butterfly Weed) plants for the residents of Sugar Grove. **Thank you, Midwest Groundcovers!** These plants will be available at the Beautification & Gardening Committee meeting on June 12 at the Sugar Grove Library.



Additionally, the Beautification & Gardening Committee will welcome Kathleen Carr from [The Growing Scene, Inc.](#) Kathleen will give a brief presentation on planting pollinator and hummingbird gardens. We hope to see you there!

The Virgil Gilman Trail Bridge was delivered on Tuesday, June 3.

The Virgil Gilman Trail closure will resume on Monday, as it did in the fall. After the bridge is set, D Construction will proceed with earthwork and bike path installation. If all goes well, it should wrap up around July 21st.

Sugar Grove 2025 Road Program

The 2025 Road Program will involve street resurfacing, curb and gutter repairs, sidewalk repairs, and minor storm sewer repairs. This work is necessary to improve safety and help eliminate the pavement deterioration adjacent to these areas. The work is anticipated to start on or about June 16th and should be complete in 30 days.
