

HTC Prison Ministry

Launched in September 2025, the Haiti Teen Challenge Prison Program provides spiritual, legal, psychological, and psychosocial support to individuals within Haiti's prison system. Through a holistic approach, the program seeks to address emotional, relational, and spiritual needs while helping participants rediscover hope and purpose.

Through mentorship, discipleship, rehabilitation services, and the support of dedicated partners, men and women are finding renewed dignity and opportunities for lasting transformation. Early outcomes have already included baptisms, family reunification efforts, and steps toward successful reintegration.

Alumni Care Program

The Haiti Teen Challenge Alumni Care Program supports graduates as they transition from residential rehabilitation back into everyday life. Recognizing that recovery is a long-term journey, the program follows graduates for up to five (5) years, offering continued guidance, encouragement, and practical support as they pursue healthy and productive futures.

Through the Alumni Care Program, graduates may receive assistance with professional training, university or vocational school scholarships, mentorship, and support in launching small businesses or income-generating projects. The program is designed to help former students build stability, independence, and long-term success while remaining connected to a supportive community.

Luxon's Journey

Restored & Moving Forward

“Through commitment, support, and a desire for change, Luxon rebuilt his life and discovered renewed purpose.”

When **Luxon Maignan** joined the 19th class of the Men's Center at Haiti Teen Challenge, he was struggling with alcohol addiction, sexual addiction, and a lack of direction for his future. Through his commitment, the support he received, and his desire for change, he gradually rebuilt his life, developing discipline, confidence, and a renewed sense of purpose.

Today, Luxon is one of the program's scholarship recipients and is pursuing his university studies with determination in his third year of dentistry.

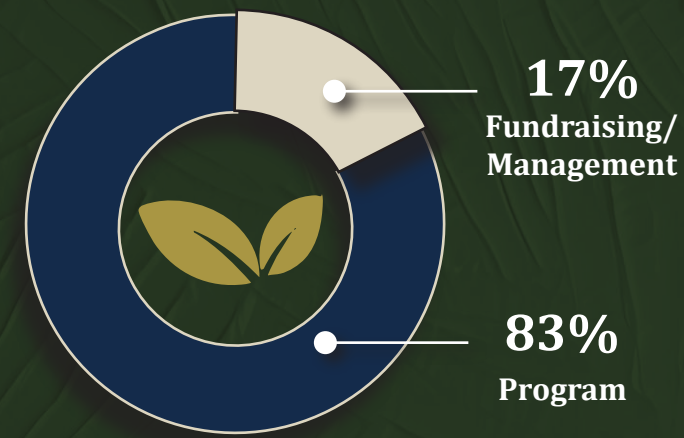

 If you have been following Haiti, you know this has been a difficult year marked by unrest, hardship, and uncertainty. Yet even in the midst of it all, God has faithfully sustained Haiti Teen Challenge. That is no small thing, and it would not have been possible without you.

Rooted in Christ is more than the theme of this report. It is the story of this ministry. Like a tree planted by living water, we have remained standing through every storm. Our roots have grown deeper, and the fruit has multiplied: transformed lives, restored families, and young leaders rising with purpose and hope.

- This year:
- Young men once trapped in addiction, trauma, and violence are discovering their identity as godly leaders and men of integrity.
 - Our women's program continues to be a place of healing where young women break generational cycles and grow in confidence, education, and faith.
 - Our alumni program reminds us that graduation is only the beginning. This year, 101 alumni enrolled in university, 82 received life skills training, and many found employment, were baptized, and committed their lives to Christ.
 - Through our prison ministry, the Gospel continues to bring hope, pastoral care, and restoration in places where hope often seems impossible.

Serving on the front lines of this ministry, I carry this work close to my heart every day. And one of the greatest encouragements is knowing we do not stand alone.

Your generosity, prayers, and faithfulness make this work possible. You are not simply donors; you are partners, family, and part of the root system that allows this ministry to keep bearing fruit.

HTC Men's Center



Founded in 2011, the Haiti Teen Challenge Men's Center is a residential rehabilitation program for young men between the ages of 18 and 24 who are struggling with drug addiction and destructive lifestyles. As the only long-term Christian residential recovery program of its kind in Haiti, the center provides a safe, structured, and supportive environment where participants can begin rebuilding their lives physically, emotionally, spiritually, and socially.

The 18-month program combines biblical discipleship, personal development, counseling, education, work therapy, mentorship, and community living to help students break cycles of addiction and rediscover purpose and dignity. Beyond sobriety, the program's goal is lasting life transformation, empowering young men to reintegrate into society as healthy, responsible, and hope-filled individuals.

Discovered New Life

Berlens PETIT-HOMME, a 24-year-old from Carrefour-Feuilles, struggled with alcohol, drugs, and life-draining influences before entering the Haiti Teen Challenge Men's Center. There he discovered God's love and the value of his life. On February 3, 2026, he committed his life to Jesus Christ, beginning a completely new journey.



HTC Women's Center

Established in 2016, the Haiti Teen Challenge Women's Center is a residential rehabilitation program dedicated to helping women overcome drug addiction, trauma, and harmful life patterns. Through a compassionate and structured environment, the program offers women an opportunity to heal, rebuild their lives, and rediscover their identity and worth.

Like the men's program, the Women's Center offers an 18-month residential experience focused on spiritual growth, counseling, life skills, education, mentorship, and community support. The program seeks not only to address addiction itself, but also the underlying challenges that often accompany it, helping women move toward long-term restoration, stability, and renewed hope for the future.

Through God's provision and the generosity of our donors, we purchased the Women's Center facilities in 2025, creating a lasting foundation for ministry and care.

A Life Renewed

Stania Virgil, originally from Delmas, came to Haiti Teen Challenge after experiencing a life marked by drugs, unhealthy relationships, abuse, hurtful influences, and deep hopelessness following her parents' separation.

After entering the program in January 2025, she rededicated her life to Christ and was later baptized. Through the guidance, encouragement, teachings, and life-skills training she received at the Women's Center, her dreams, mindset, and emotions began to transform.

Today, Stania is experiencing joy, peace, and a renewed sense of purpose as she learns to leave her past behind, follow God's plan for her life, and become a positive example for her family and community.

They will be called OAKS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, a planting of the Lord for the display of His splendor.
