Acrylic Paint

Jed Dorsey uses Winsor Newton Professional Acrylics (artist-quality / heavy body paints) but if you have something else, or student-grade paint, use that! If you can afford to buy ONE color in artist-quality paint, we recommend yellow (coverage in artist-quality is better than student-grade, especially in yellows).

The colors you will need are listed below (they are Winsor Newton Professional Acrylic color names):

- Cadmium Yellow Light or Medium
- Permanent Rose (often called Quinacridone Red in other brands - pigment # is PV19)
- Ultramarine Blue
- Phthalo Blue (green shade) & Phthalo Green (blue shade)
- Titanium White & Mars Black

Don't worry about having all the exact colors - **the main thing is simply to have each of the primary colors: one yellow, one red, one blue, plus white and black.** As long as you have these, you will be able to participate. (Note: Dianna Shyne mostly uses Golden paint.)

Brushes

Some wonderful brushes are Princeton Catalyst (long handles). Especially **Flats in sizes 4, 6, 10, & 12** (and a small **Round #1 or #2**.) Those are professional brushes but you can use a student-grade set that has a variety of sizes. Synthetic brushes are best with acrylics. (Note: Dianna sometimes uses a 2" brush to put a wash on the canvas.)

Canvases

You will need 2 square painting surfaces (eg. 8x8, 10x10, 12x12) and 1 rectangular painting surface (eg. 8x10, 11x14, 12x16). Canvas panels are great.

Palette

Jed and Dianna's favorite is the Masterson Sta-Wet palette (12x16), but you can use whatever you have even if it's a paper plate. You can also use disposable palette paper that comes in a pad.

Value Finder

This will help you see the values (darkness or lightness) in the scene you are painting.

Other Helpful Tools

Sheet Protector - Clear, plastic 8.5x11 document sleeve and dry erase marker for experimenting (w/Dianna)

Spray Bottle - For keeping paint moist on palette & on painting (sometimes).

Paper Towels - For drying/wiping your wet paintbrush.

Water Buckets - For washing brushes.

Optional: Acrylic marker, pencil, and color shaper.
