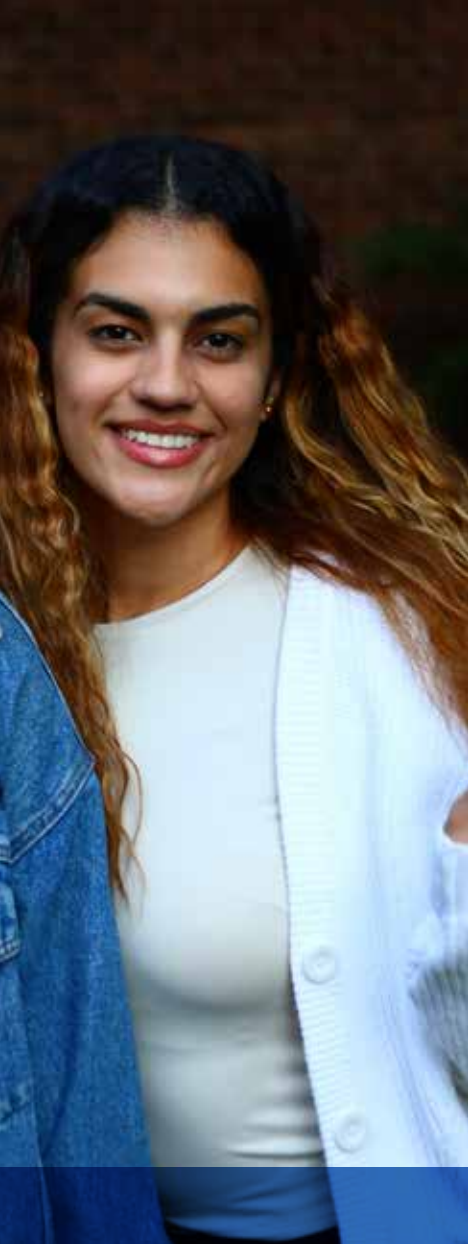
PROGRAMS TO MATCH YOUR AMBITIONS
