



Parent/Legal Guardian Code of Conduct

I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will remember that my child plays soccer for his/her enjoyment, not mine.

I will never place the value of winning over the safety and welfare of the players.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by treating all players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators with dignity and respect at every game, practice or other youth sports event. Examples include booing or taunting, refusing to shake hands, etc.

I will refrain from criticizing game officials, and will respect their authority and decisions during games.

I will refrain from criticizing my own athlete or any other athlete at any time.

I will refrain from “side line” coaching and will leave all coaching responsibilities to the coaches.

I will not use profanity, vulgar language or mannerisms at any time.

I will not make physical contact with any player, coach, official, spectator, or sports facility personnel.

I will treat all players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability. I will insist my athlete do the same.

I will respect the property, facilities and equipment used at all sports facilities—home and away.

I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my athlete or the safety of others.

I will refrain from the use of drugs, tobacco and alcohol at all practices, games, tournaments or any other club event.

I have read and understand the SUSC Parent Code of Conduct and I agree to support and promote this **Parent/Legal Guardian Code of Conduct**. Further, my failure to comply with this agreement or my participation in any of the outlined actions will result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from Salisbury United Soccer Club.
