WILDLIFE

Wildlife abounds in and around Eagles Landing. Migrating birds, woodpeckers, gopher tortoises, large mouth bass & pan fish, an occasional otter and sand hill cranes.

Bullfrogs and painted turtles are found along the banks and lily pads. There are bald eagles, ducks, osprey, barn owls, and red tail hawks, that visit.

The pinelands and scrub palms make for a great native habitat along with cypress, oaks, duck potato, Dahoon holly and other natives for nesting and food sources for wildlife.

Eagles Landing Rules

- EAGLES LANDING is an Agra-tourism facility. You are assuming the risk & liability while on the property, and will be required to sign a waiver for registering to camp.
- All group activities are to be adult supervised
- We are a working camp and participants will setup and takedown all equipment used for their outing.
- **“No trace campground”**- nothing left at site
- No vehicle traffic beyond the front roped parking area. Foot traffic only in Camp
- This facility is powered by solar electric and well water, “off grid site PLEASE be a good steward of electric & water
- All events are considered - **“No Trace Outings”** including garbage removal from camp
- No Alcoholic beverages
- Hospitality fires in designated fire rings only. **No Bonfires!** Fires are **Never** to be left unattended!
- Do not damage or cut trees or vegetation at Eagle’s Landing
- Must wear life preservers if using kayaks, canoes or row boats
- You must have a buddy with you at all times when on the water in paddle crafts and have adult supervision of water front activities
- Catch & Release fishing only
- Quiet hours are from 10pm-7am.
- **For emergencies call 911**
- **Hospital is 13 miles away in Sebastian, Fl**
