42 persons in families served in 2015

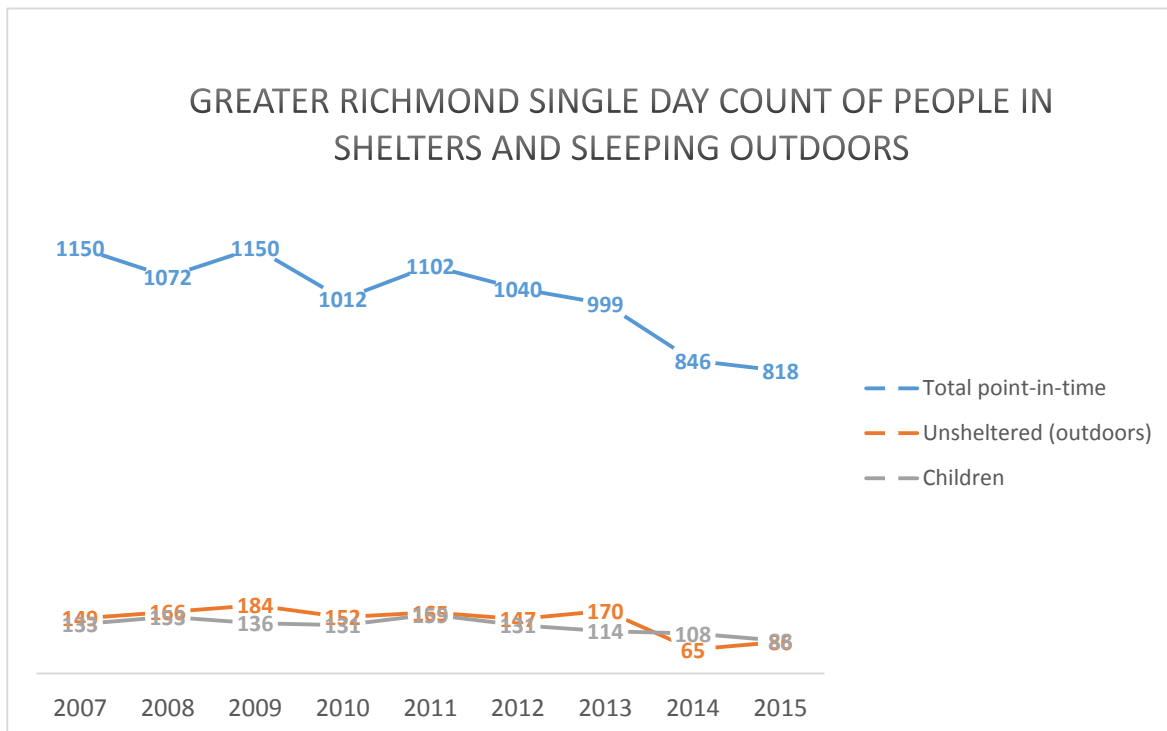
Permanent Supportive Housing Use:

514 individuals served in 2015

HIGHLIGHTS:

* Between Oct. 2014 and Sept. 2015, our region successfully housed over 350 homeless veterans!

* Rapid rehousing housed 204 people in families in 2014, and helped bring down the median length of homelessness for families to 60 days from 120 days!
