Case conferencing brings service providers and community partners together to coordinate support for individuals and families experiencing homelessness.



Types of Case Conferencing:

Singles

Focused on support for individual adults in emergency shelter.

Families

Addressing the needs of families.

Older Adults

Coordinated support for seniors.

MCOs

Homeward meets with all five Managed Care Organizations on a rotating schedule; submit a consent form to see if attendance is needed.

Case Specific

Case-specific case conferencing led by Homeward to coordinate targeted solutions for specific needs or subpopulations.

Community Outreach

Coordinated outreach to better serve people staying outdoors.

Youth & Young Adults

Coordinated support for individuals ages 18-24, formerly in foster care.

Targeted Prevention

Preventing family homelessness
