


KNIGHTS' CORNER

Why Worry About Trash in the Environment?

- Trash, including everything from plastic bags and paper to food waste, is generated daily by households, individuals, and businesses.
- Globally, the solid-waste management sector is usually one of the top three greenhouse gas emitters.
- Trash contributes about 5% of carbon dioxide emissions and up to 20% of methane emissions.
- Poor waste management can lead to disease transmission, respiratory problems, water and soil contamination, air pollution, and marine pollution.
- Worldwide, waste is increasing at an alarming rate, and its mismanagement is exacerbating the climate crisis.
- Some of the key sources of emissions from trash are carbon dioxide generated as waste decomposes and methane generated by the mismanagement of organic matter.
- When trash is safely isolated from the environment, the methane it generates can be captured.
- The mismanagement of waste also directly contributes to flooding and pollution. If it is not collected properly, it can block drains or canals and exacerbate flooding, which can aid the spread of diseases.
- Waste generation is rapidly increasing: by 2050 municipal waste is anticipated to outpace population growth by more than 200%.
- People in low-income countries generate one quarter of what high-income individuals generate daily.
