

Eucharistic Revival

Definition from The Baltimore Catechism:

"A *sacrament* is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give *grace*."

The greatest gift that God can give us is the gift of God's very self.

Karl Rahner and other theologians speak of *grace* as "God's personal self-communication."

Grace is not so much something that is given but someone who is experienced as **present**.

This is why many theologians today do not speak so much of *sacraments "giving grace"* but as sacramental celebrations *"enabling us to experience grace,"* to touch *grace* itself, to contact the all-pervading *presence* of the loving God who sustains all created things in existence. The *sacraments* allow us to become conscious and aware of God's greatest gift: the creative, sustaining, loving *presence* of God.

Our understanding of *sacrament* is related to our ideas of *grace* and *presence*. Not only the Eucharist, but each of the *sacraments* is a celebration of *God's real presence*.


