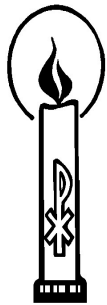

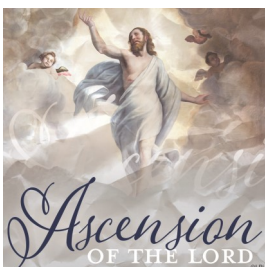

Dear Friends,

Last week before all the Masses, I had the sad task of announcing that Deacon Pat Shanley's wife, Jeanne, had suffered a cerebral hemorrhage on Wednesday the 10th along with several other complications. On Sunday evening (the 14th) at 5:20 pm, surrounded by family she was given back to God.

Pat and Jeanne and I have been friends for all of 40 years. I've known them since before I was ordained. I have memories and stories of our sitting together in their back yard watching their kids grow and of our laughing together til our sides hurt as life unfolded before us.

The best part was watching how Pat and Jeanne loved each other. Pat would literally light up when she walked into the room, and I used to tease him about it. Instead of being embarrassed he would joyfully proclaim, "I've been crazy about her for over 40 years!" and I thought, "Every spouse should be loved this deeply."

When Deacon Pat and Jeanne joined our faith community last June, it allowed us to spend more time together than we have in the past. During that time, I became aware of something I was aware of but could not put my finger on. It became increasingly aware to me of how truly holy Jeanne was. It was like she had the ability to see into your soul with no judgement involved. This gift served her well as a Spiritual Director at the Mercy Spiritual Center.

Pat and Jeanne and I had a running joke that when we saw each other we would hug. After hugging Jeanne, I would turn to Pat and say, "Hey mister, I love your wife ...is that OK?" And Pat would laugh and say, "Yeah, everybody else does."

Forty years is too short a time for friendships like theirs and far too short a time for marriages so blessed, but at least we can find consolation that during that short time we were able to experience holiness.

In the words of Pope Francis ---

"It is my hope that the Eucharistic Revival Congress will inspire Catholics throughout the country to discover anew the sense of wonder and awe at the Lord's great gift of himself and to spend time with him in the celebration of the Holy Mass and in personal prayer and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament.

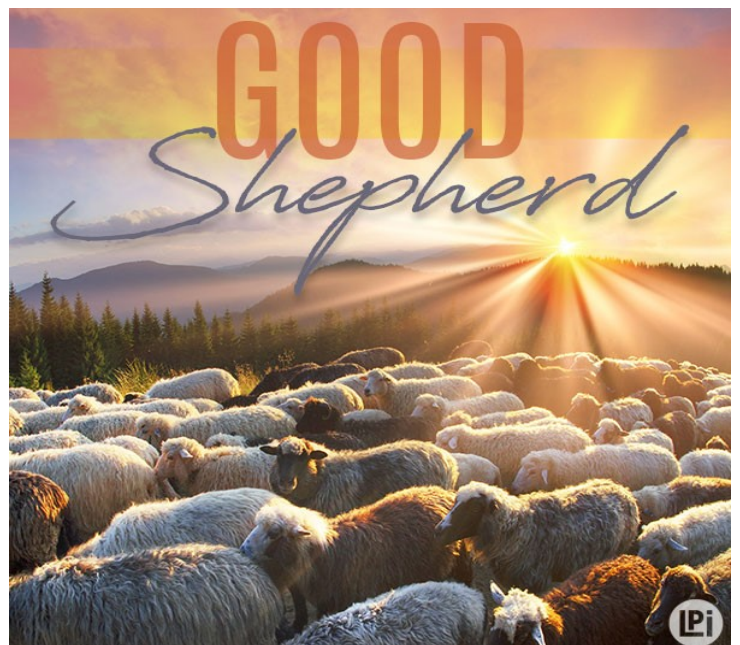
