

Eucharistic Revival

Pope Francis urges to remove the stones that "block the door of our hearts"

Pope Francis presided over this past Easter Vigil service at the Vatican, delivering a 10-minute homily and baptizing eight people. Francis entered the darkened, silent St. Peter's Basilica in his wheelchair, took his place in a chair and offered an opening prayer.

Later, Francis delivered a 10-minute homily in a strong voice, referring to the stone that the faithful believe was removed from Christ's tomb after Christ's death.

Francis urged Catholics to remove the stones in their lives that "block the door of our hearts, stifling life, extinguishing hope, imprisoning us in the tomb of our fears and regrets."

> "Let us lift our eyes to him and ask that the power of his resurrection may roll away the heavy stones that weigh down our souls," he said. --from the National Catholic Reporter

St. Columba Food Pantry: cereal, soup, canned vegetables.


St. Mary's Food Pantry: powdered milk, evaporated milk, juice mixes, soups, crackers
