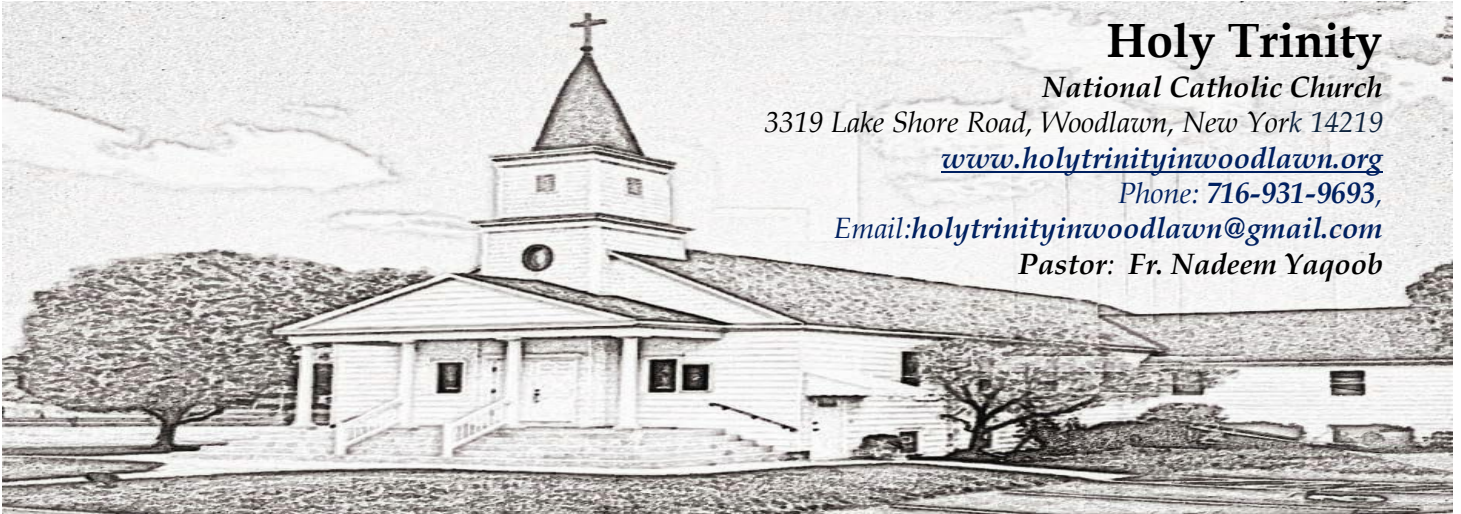

Joy in Patience

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, today we celebrate third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday, Rejoice in the Lord). The gospel teaches us of Jesus' message to John the Baptist, the blind will regain their sight, the lame now can walk, the lepers be cleansed, the deaf now can hear, the dead has been raised, the poor receive the Good News and all this happen when John was in prison. This reminds us that despite the darkness around us God continuously moves and works.
