

## From Pastor's Desk God's Ways

Dear brothers and sisters, the Gospel proclaims today, how the birth of our lord Jesus came about. It is time to reflect on the figure of Jospeh which the Gospel highlights. Jospeh in his righteousness decided to leave Mary quietly because Mary was found with child. Joseph at that time did not know that it is through the Holy Spirit. Then the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, revealing mystery to him. He believed what the angel of the Lord has commanded him. He took Mary as his wife into his house. He named God's Son, their son Jesus. Brothers and sisters, as we are set to conclude advent season, let us look to Joseph. Let him be our inspiration and guide to wake up and follow God's Word. In the first reading from Isaiah 7:10-14 we have a king named Ahaz; this king is stubborn and hardheaded. He refused to listen to prophet Isaiah. He would rather rely on his capacity to forge human alliances. Isaiah tells him to approach God, God has his ways, God is the true King and God would alert you, guide you in your way of administering God's people. Go to God, ask for a sign and doing that you will save God's people and yourself. Ahaz said, no I will not ask, I will not tempt the Lord! Isaiah said, God will still give you the sign that you do not want, "therefore the Lord himself will give you this sign, the virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel." Which means God is with us. How many times we have been like Ahaz, refusing to go to God, refusing to ask God and refusing to consult with God how we should comport ourselves.
