Following the full-school vision screenings, VTL's staff worked with our nursing team to schedule full eye exams for students that needed additional testing in their mobile vision clinic. The mobile vision van has additional medical equipment to help their licensed optometrist provide full optometric exams.

Following the screenings and eye exams, VTL returned to the school to custom fit the glasses for each student that needed them, and instructed them on caring for and cleaning their lenses.

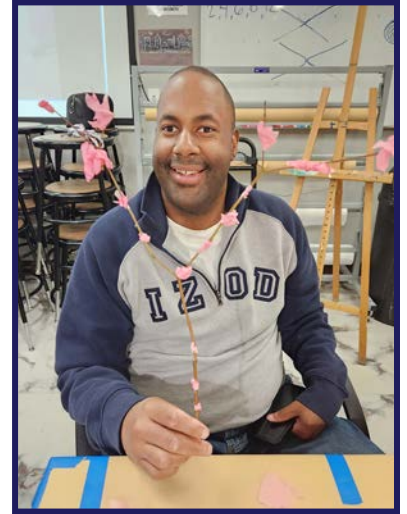


Fairhaven Foundation Provides Art Enrichment Classes
