Adopt a Garden Bed

Steve has removed the suckers off of the trees. Weed killer has been applied to the grounds. Bed closest to the parish center has been sprayed. All beds will be sprayed by Friday.

Steve is congratulated for his continuing efforts.

Spoke about the parking lot stone, its care and replacement.

Table and Chair donation update (Rita)

Subsequent to last meeting there was some reaction to the table selection. Father Justin. Carol, Bryanna, Heather and Rita met to talk about what is really needed. Added more tables, table dolly and more chairs.

We will be getting rid of the 60 broken chairs.

Purchases should be completed by the end of the month.

Beehive for drains (Mike)

Discussed the beehive drain covers. The covers will improve the drainage of the school courtyard. Talked about installation and selection of covers.

Camera has been installed in the courtyard on Monday, June 8th. School principal has been informed and approves. Rain on June 10th showed no flooding. This will continue until the week before schools starts.

Discussed blocking off of the parking lots and the circle drive to comply with regulations for the overflight. The time will be at 1:00 pm

Locker painting (Steve)

Steve has created a process for painting to locker doors. Discussed details and logistics for painting 30-40 at a time. Multiple days have been planned. Half of the parish hall will be needed for prep, paint and primer and then painting. Painting will begin after the rummage sale is completed.

We have volunteers. Work to be coordinated by Bryanna.

Talked about the floors of the lockers. Choice between bedliner or plastic inlay. Discussion. Consensus is bedliner first. If wear more than we expect then we can go with flooring inlay.

Storage

The transoms in the school look fantastic. Work will continue.

Storage methods and means to be discussed. Field trip to the various spaces... Talked about means and methods. Cabinets that lock are preferred but are more expensive. This will be an ongoing project.

Parish Center rooftop units (Jerry and Tom)

The roof top units are reaching end of life. They are ten-year units.

Discussion about condition, means methods of what we need to consider with the HVAC.

Decision on how to proceed will need to be made so are ready for heating season.

Athletic Association updates

Can we paint the bathrooms? The separations in the bathrooms are corroding and need painting. Flooring on the stairs needs renewal. Discussed causes and repair methods. This is an ongoing project.
