The Stewardship committee wants to add these statements to our website. There was a lot of feedback regarding what was proposed and what changes could be made. It was decided to have council members review the information presented and send an email directly to Duane with their comments. No decision was

made regarding the Vision and Mission, the topic will be presented again in November to Pastoral council for a decision.
