

PROJECT CASE STUDY NEWTOWN HIGH SCHOOL KITCHEN REFURBISHMENT

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The commercial kitchen in this high school was in need of updating and modernisation. The ventilation needed modernising, the equipment had reached the end of its serviceable life and the functionality of the kitchen required improvement to meet the demands of daily school life.





This project was required to be fully completed within the school summer holidays, as the kitchen was in contact use during term time. The would mean that work could not commence until the start of July and would need to be fully completed and operational before the start of the new school, year in September.







PROJECT OVERVIEW

This complete kitchen refurbishment project was completed successfully within the 6 week period. Servery wall partitions were removed along with roller shutters, the existing floor was removed, drainage works carried out and new flooring installed. New ventilation was installed in the roof, alongside electrical works to accommodate commercial kitchen appliances and dwarf walls were built to allow installation of new refrigeration units. Plastering of walls and decoration, new ceilings and fire protection systems installed and plumbing, heating and water works completed. On completion this is now a fully functioning commercial kitchen ready for the start of the new school year.
