St. Mark/St. Matthew Combined Parish Family School Strategic Planning



Listening Session feedback from June 4 and 5, 2025

St. Mark and St. Matthew schools will combine for the 2026-27 school year due to declining enrollment and resulting financial issues. Fr. Ross convened a Strategic Planning Steering Committee to develop a plan for the new combined school. The members of the Steering Committee include:

- Fr. Ross
- St. Mark Tom Martin (chair), Ian Audette, Ruth Foisy, Kathy Keck, Leo Van Hollebeke
- St. Matthew John Hickman, Rick O'Leary, Julie Prepotente, Monica Williams

The Steering Committee held listening sessions at each parish on June 4 and 5. About 100 people attended. Tom Martin shared the work plan for the committee and the work groups who will address many of the key issues for the combined school. The work groups are made up of parents, parishioners, staff and teachers to address the following areas:

- Curriculum Kathy Keck and Julie Prepotente (leads)
- Community/Marketing Ruth Foisy, Leo Van Hollebeke (leads)
- Finance John Hickman (lead)
- Staffing Kathy Keck, Julie Prepotente (lead)
- Strategic Tom Martin (lead)

The work groups will complete tasks by September/early October. A draft report will be available for review by parishioners in November. Feedback sessions will be held in November with a final set of recommendations given to Father Ross in December of 2025. This will provide the necessary information needed by parents to sign a contract for the 2026-27 school year.

In addition to answering questions at the listening sessions, a survey of hopes and concerns was conducted. Key themes from the survey include:

Hopes

• Strong Catholic Identity

- Sustainable school, enrollment, finances, staff, buildings
- Strong curriculum that prepares students for high school and builds disciples
- Strong community integrated with the parish
- A transparent process for the creation of the combined school

Concerns

- Not enough students will enroll
- Change is hard
- Challenges with combining/collaboration of cultures
- Connection to the Partners in the Gospel process and long-term impact on use of parish sites.

These themes and the detailed survey results will be used by the Steering Committee and the work groups as inputs in the process. In addition, the most frequent questions and responses from the listening sessions can be found below.

Frequently Asked Questions

<u>Question:</u> Where will the combined school be located? How will the school location impact use of churches and other buildings at the two parishes?

<u>Response</u>: The school location will be recommended by the Steering Committee. That decision will be independent but serve as a consideration to the process of determining the long-term use of parish buildings and properties under Partners in the Gospel. This phase will begin over the next year.

Question: What will the curriculum for the combined school be?

<u>Response</u>: The Curriculum work group will draw on the best elements of each school to develop a curriculum of the combined school.

<u>Question:</u> What will happen to teachers who are not asked to teach at the combined school?

<u>**Response:**</u> Beyond normal turnover and retirements, any teachers not asked to work at the combined school, will work with the Archdiocesan Office of Catholic Schools to identify other opportunities in Catholic schools in the area.

Question: What will happen to the endowments of the two schools?

<u>**Response:**</u> The legal documents for setting up of the endowments will be adhered to. Each has clauses that would allow Pastoral Council and the pastor to allow the endowments to be committed to the new combined school.
