### ROSARY JUBILEE UPDATE— Your Hands Are Changing Lives!

Great news! St. Matthew Parish has received a matching -fund grant from the St. Joseph Foundation of the Archdiocese of Seattle. Every dollar you give toward the Rosary Jubilee Project will now be doubled up to the grant amount of \$1,725 to buy beads, crucifixes, cord, and other supplies. Thanks to 75 generous volunteers, we have already handcrafted 700 rosaries. Our shared mission is to reach 2,025 Jubilee Rosaries to be distributed to people who need encouragement most hospital patients, the homebound, the incarcerated, and others on the margins.

• A rosary in a hospital room becomes a lifeline of peace when fear clouds a diagnosis.

• A rosary in a prison cell whispers dignity and belonging when hope feels out of reach.

• A rosary in an empty apartment reminds the lonely that an entire parish family is praying with them.

These simple beads, blessed by your time and love, turn isolation into communion and despair into renewed strength.

## **REGARDING DAILY MASS TIMES!**

Our Parish Family #12 **Daily Mass Schedule has changed.** To be consistent with weekday morning Mass times at both parishes and schools, and to recognize the scheduling demands on our Pastor and Parochial Vicar, the daily Mass times starting July 1, 2025 are as follows:

Wednesday	St. Mark	6pm (5pm Confession)
Thursday	St. Matthew	9am
Friday	St. Matthew	8:30am (On 1st Fridays— Anointing of the Sick)
	St. Mark	9am (followed by 24-hour Adoration)
Saturday	St. Mark	9am (Benediction before Mass)

When we have a funeral Mass scheduled on a day where we normally have a daily Mass, daily Mass is canceled, and regular attendees are invited to attend the funeral Mass to support the family. This does not change the Saturday 5pm Mass or the Sunday 8am and 10am Mass times!
