AUGUST 17, 2025 – 20TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus said "I came to cast fire upon the earth and how I wish it were already blazing. I have a baptism (Cross) that I must still receive, and how great is my distress until it is accomplished!"

In *Luke 12:49-53*, Jesus speaks about the division his coming will bring, that will cause conflict within families. He states that he came to bring fire to the earth and is eager for it to



be already kindled, highlighting the intensity of his mission. This "fire" represents the Holy Spirit's influence, which purifies and refines the believer, but also exposes sin and creates division. This division will be so profound that even those within close relationships will be split, with some siding with Jesus and others opposing him. It's a fiery judgment that separates those who passed the trials of discipleship against those who failed. While the message can be divisive, the ultimate goal is to bring people together in love and faith even if it means facing conflict along the way. The passage also calls for discernment, urging people to recognize the signs of the times and to be ready for the consequences for not following Jesus.

PARISH FAMILY ADVISORY COUNCIL FORMING

Our parish family of St. Mark and St. Matthew is ready to begin a strategic pastoral planning process. We will be following the Partners in the Gospel process called the **One Parish Plan** (**OPP**). The planning process will start in earnest in early 2026 and be completed in 2028. The One Parish Plan will address several questions:

- Who are we?
- What do we want to become?
- How do we get there?
- What should we be called?

To guide the process, Fr. Ross will be appointing a Parish Family Advisory Council. Think of it as the pastoral council for the parish family of St. Mark and St. Matthew. The Council will consist of 9 to 12 parishioners who will be selected to serve. If you are interested in serving on the Parish Family Advisory Council, an application is on the website and can be found in the vestibule of each church.

Applications should be completed by the end of September, with the selection happening in October. There will likely be monthly meetings starting in November 2025, along with several listening sessions over the 2+ year period. Please prayerfully consider your interest and pray for the work of this important council.






