

SEPTEMBER 7, 2025 –

SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus said to the crowd, "And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple. In the same way, those of you who do not give up everything you have, cannot be my disciples (Luke 14:27 & 33)



The large crowd listening to Jesus's words about "counting the cost" discipleship,

featuring imagery of a king assessing his army before battle, a builder calculating funds for a tower, and people renouncing all possessions to follow Him, symbolizes the radical, commitment required to be a true disciple. That following Jesus requires a radical commitment, prioritizing Him above family, possessions, and involves willing surrender, the willingness to endure hardship, and a calculation of the personal cost before committing to discipleship. The passage uses these metaphors to emphasize that this commitment must be made with a full understanding of its consequences.



The DOO is a new position for our Parish Family- a position which will be critical in helping us come together as one Parish Family in the Partners in the Gospel initiative.

Julianna is a familiar face with 2 daughters attending St. Mark Classical School, as well as serving as the CYO Athletic Director for St. Mark & St. Matthew. She brings extensive professional experience in accounting and business practices.

St. Mark/St. Matthew Combined Parish Family School Strategic Planning Update September 2025



The St. Mark/St. Matthew School Strategic Plan committees have made great progress over the summer, preparing a plan for the combined school to commence in the 2026-27 school year. Initial recommendations are being created in the following areas:

- School Program
 - PreK-8 or K-8, 6-8 self-contained classes or middle school rotation?
 - What textbooks/resources are needed to support the teachers in teaching all subjects and continue to have a strong Catholic identity
 - What sort of staff is needed to support the school program?
- Community/marketing How do we form a community and grow?
- Finance
 - What will be the tuition structure and staffing cost?
 - O What will the cost be to the parish?
- Strategic How do we align with the parish family and where will the combined school be located?

As we draft recommendations, the steering committee will test them with a couple of focus groups in early October. A draft report should be available at the end of October and listening sessions for parents and parishioners will take place in November to provide feedback. A final set of recommendations will be given to Fr. Ross in early December, in time for parent contracts for the 2026-27 school year.

Meanwhile, efforts to build community are already underway. A number of joint events for families have occurred through the summer. More joint events between St. Matthew and St. Mark students and faculties will take place throughout the current school year. In addition, CYO sports have been combined for the coming sports seasons. All this is done with the intent of families to get know each other.

We want to thank the various committees for prioritizing the well-being of all our students and teachers and for their hard work throughout the summer.

Please pray for the efforts of the Steering Committee as we move forward to create a quality Catholic education for our combined faith community.

PARISH FAMILY ADVISORY COUNCIL FORMING

Our parish family of St. Mark and St. Matthew is ready to begin a strategic pastoral planning process. We will be following the Partners in the Gospel process called the One Parish Plan (OPP). The planning process will start in earnest in early 2026 and be completed in 2028. The One Parish Plan will address several questions:


- Who are we?

Applications should be completed by the end of September with the selection of members in October. Monthly meetings will likely be held starting November 2025 along with several listening sessions over the 2+ year period. Please prayerfully consider your interest and pray for the work of this important council.
