DECEMBER 28, 2025 – THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY & JOSEPH

In St. Matthew's Gospel, we see God's quiet but faithful guidance at work. God tells Joseph to take his family and flee to Egypt. After a time of fear, uncertainty, and exile, Joseph is once again spoken to in a dream and invited to lead his family home. His obedience is immediate and trusting, even though the journey ahead remains unclear. Joseph does not ask for guarantees, he simply listens and acts.



This passage reminds us that God's protection does not always remove danger but often guide us safely through it. The Holy Family's return from Egypt fulfills God's promise and reveals that even moments of displacement and suffering are woven into His saving plan.
