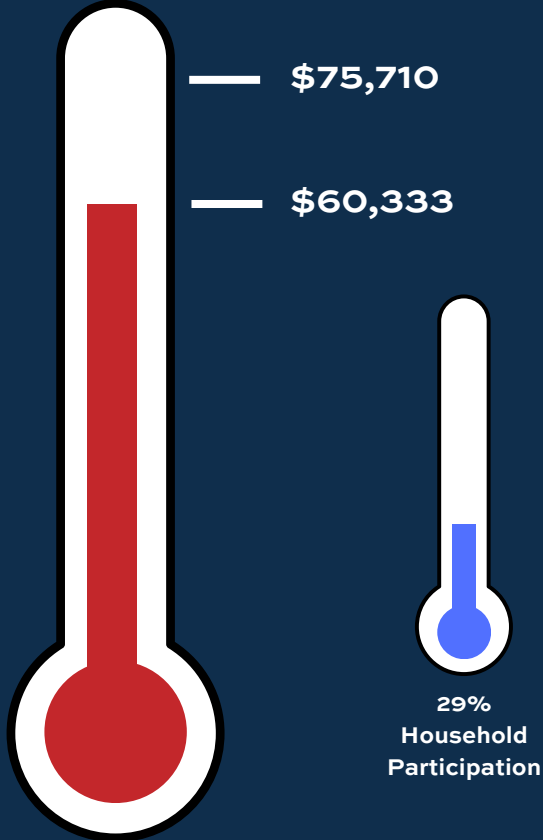

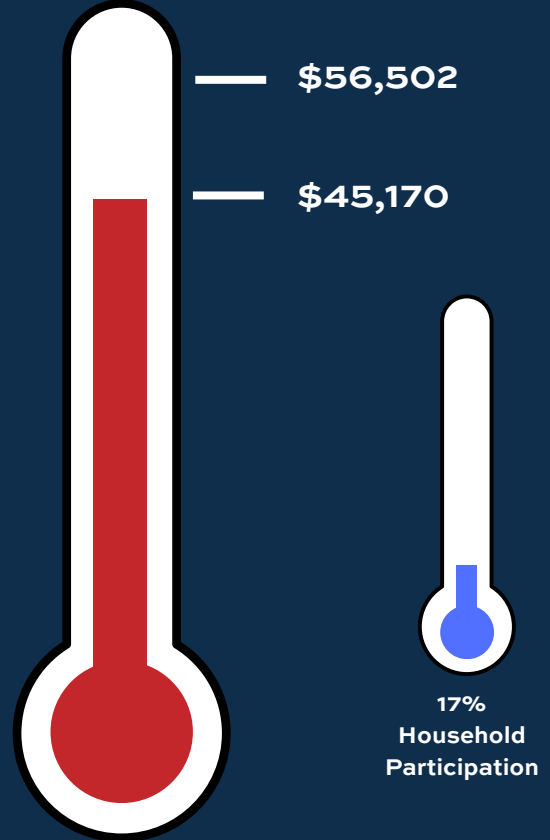


St. Mark Goal: \$75,710
